Cooper Wilcomb Award:

Jane Nelson Award:

This award recognizes Boise Y Swim Team swimmers and volunteers who have been identified by members of the team as exhibiting a high level of sportsmanship and citizenship, as well as a commitment to participation and service on the Team. The award is presented in memory of Jane Nelson, the team treasurer in 1973. Jane was instrumental in getting the team established on a sound financial footing while promoting sportsmanship at the highest level.

Volunteer of the Year:

Each year, the swim team recognizes at least one volunteer who has gone above and beyond helping the team. This year, our Volunteer Awards were Dallas Turner and Gwynne Chandler.
